TAKING A MEDICAL CASE HISTORY

STEPS IN EVALUATING A CLIENT WITH A PHYSICAL ILLNESS FOR CORE ENERGETICS WORK

Evaluation Starts with First Phone Call:

LISTEN....

- First Impressions .
- Voice (Tone, pressure)
- Resistances
- Anxiety / eagerness
- Boundaries
- Thought forms / Negative believes

Initial Interview & Exam:

SEE, LISTEN, SMELL, TOUCH.....

- 1) Evaluate the Level of Functioning: before and after onset of illness, what is the level of incapacitation
- 2) What is the Initial Complaint?
- 3) What is the Age, Gender, Ethnic, Religious & Cultural background?
- 4) Sexual Orientation?
- 5) General Level of Functioning?
 - Schooling (Degrees)
 - Career
 - Schooling/career ratio
 - Social status
 - **Relationships & Friends** •
 - Marital status, children, parents to take care of
 - Intelligence/accomplishment ratio
 - Financial Standing. (Prosperous?/Debts?)
 - **Hobbies**?

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- 6) Level of Self Care (also see handout)
 - Body weight
 - Exercise
 - Grooming
 - Nutrition, Diet
 - Supplementation
 - Traditional medical care
 - Dental care
 - Alternative care
- 7) Bodily functions:
 - Sleep patterns
 - Dream life
 - Eating habits
 - Elimination (evacuation, urination)
- 8) Sexual functioning
 - Female: menstruation, sexual issues
 - Male: Erectile functioning
 - Ability to have an Orgasm
 - Fertility
 - Puberty/adolescence issues
 - Sexual orientation
 - Past and present sexual activity level
 - Sexual Ageing (Menopause/Andropause)
 - Sexual abuse issues

9) Organ Symptoms:

- Which Organs or Body Systems are affected?
- List specific illnesses that may be important to know about before doing bodywork. ("Caveats!")
- List specific illnesses that may be linked to a underlying psycho- somatic component.
- Is there any connection between external events and the onset of an illness?
- Is there any obvious meaning or symbology with this illness?
- 10) Psychiatric & Psychological History: When? Why? What treatment? Result?
- 11) Hospitalizations, Surgeries. When? Why? What treatment? Result?
- 12) Medications:
 - List:
 - Name of Medication,
 - Dose & intended Purpose.

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- Is it effective?
- What are the side effects?
- Who prescribed it?
- **Duration?**

11)Medical Evaluation / Exam (if applicable)

- Medical Information: (if available)
- Doctor's reports & Medications
- Lab tests
- X-rays

12)Core Energetics Evaluation:

- Mask, Lower Self, Higher Self
- Character issues(s)
- General Behavioral Observations
- Level of Life Force
- Energy Field
- List Energetic Blocks
- List Energetic Leaks
- Skin Color & Temperature

13)Prognosis:

The treatment outcome depends on

3 aspects:

- 1) skill of therapist
- 2) level of neurosis (= defense)
- patient participation (ego strength & self responsibility and willingness for change and to follow-up.)

MEMO to the Core Therapist:

- See the beautiful, creative qualities of your patient. ("gifts")
- See the Character resistances (Character structures) as a creative act and the very best a client could do in a given situation.
- Find the basic qualities of the personality (reason, will, emotion)
- Don't box the client in!
- You need the bodywork to make enough energy available for changes!
- Without energy a person stays in "reason".
- Notice: The client comes into the session not fully in reality.

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
